Unprecedented flooding has caused considerable disruption to the lives of countless families and their beloved animals. The Kirkwood Animal Health programs have sheltered over 1,000 displaced animals in our small animal health facility, the Equestrian Center and the Tippie Beef Education Center. Thank you for your gift of \$650.00 to the Kirkwood Foundation for the Friends of the Animal Shelter Fund.

Kirkwood is playing a key role in the recovery efforts for the region. The Linn County Emergency Management Agency is co-located in Kirkwood's Community Training and Response Center and is the emergency operations center for this disaster. Representatives from all law enforcement agencies, military, FEMA, and Homeland Security, as well as city, county and state elected officials are operating from this center as well.

Operational space in the Kirkwood Center for Continuing Education (KCCE) is being provided to Linn County for their critical operations including the court system. An operations team from Alliant Energy has established operations at Kirkwood Training and Outreach Services (KTOS) and numerous other public and non-profit organizations and firms have established temporary operations on site as space permits.

Even the children from the Kirkwood Kids Child Care Center want to help and are creating art work to "cheer up the animals and their helpers." In addition to cats, dogs, rodents, lizards and birds, the census now includes horses that were rescued from rural Palo. **Your support is critically important and is accepted with immeasurable gratitude.** Thank you.
